

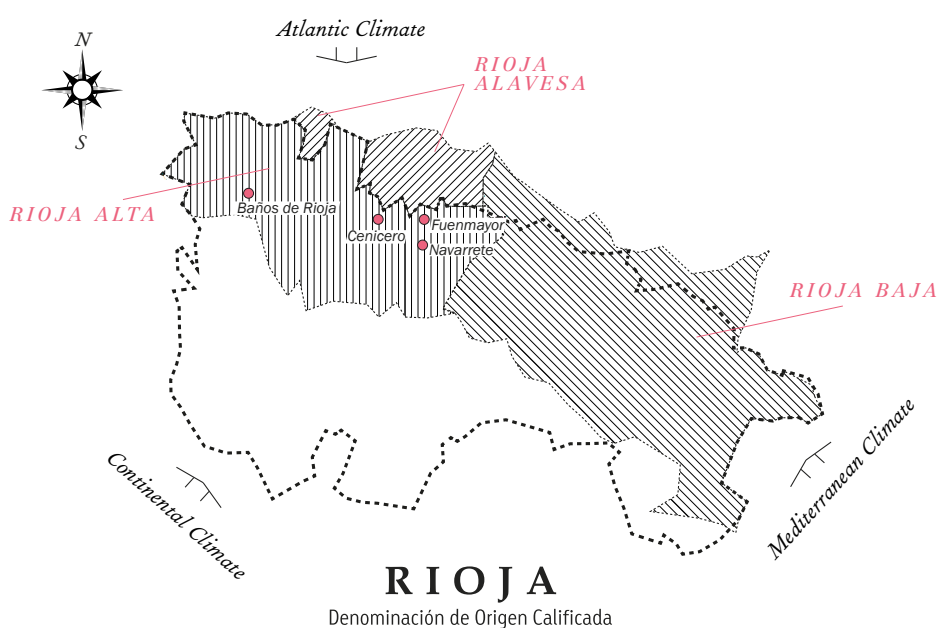

EL PEDAL ROSADO

Rioja Alta

Wine assembled from different vineyards owned by the Hernáiz family in the villages of Rioja Alta: Fuenmayor, Cenicero, Navarrete and Baños de Rioja.



Type of vineyard

The vineyards of Fuenmayor, Cenicero and Navarrete are in traditional bush vines with an average age of 35 years.

The vineyards of Fuenmayor, Navarrete and Cenicero are not in an area as extreme as those of Baños de Rioja, the microclimate is less atlantic and the wines do not require a long aging to show their full potential.

The harvest is done manually in 150 kg containers.

Varieties

70% Tempranillo, 10% Garnacha, 10% Mazuelo, 10% Viura

Wine-making

Garnacha, Mazuelo and part of Tempranillo are placed in cement and bled after 12 hours. Tempranillo and Viura are pressed directly in an inert atmosphere. The musts ferment in stainless steel tanks at a temperature of 16°.

Tasting note

Pale pink color with salmon tones. Fine and elegant aroma of red and white fruit with floral notes. The palate is fruity, light and somewhat sweet, with a good acidity that gives freshness. Ideal as an appetizer, and to accompany, vegetables and rice.
